

Publisher Questions to Western and Northern Canadian Protocol (WNCP) Mathematics Team

- 1. While it is our understanding (confirmed in previous correspondence with WNCP) that for the Mathematics Call For Resources (CFR) publishers are to submit two units of the Teacher Guide in Final Form, the rest in "formatted pages", the current wording of the CFR specifies that photos must be in place, -- "Complete 600 dpi black-and-white laser proofs with photo scans in position" -- without explicitly saying that this applies only to the units that are being submitted in Final Form.**

Can you please confirm that this criterion (specifically as regards the photo scans) refers only to the units that are being submitted in Final Form, and not to the balance of the (formatted) units?

WNCP Response: The expectation is that publishers will include two units of the Teacher Guide in Final Form, the rest in "formatted" pages. It is not the expectation of the WNCP Mathematics Team that the actual "complete 600 dpi black-and-white laser proofs with photo scans in position" be provided in the pages that are not in Final Form. However, reviewers need to know where the photos will be placed on these formatted pages and have an indication as to what type of photo will be used, i.e. the pyramids in Edmonton.
